

3v3 Assignment Policy

- 1) On time referee applicants will have priority over late applicants.
- 2) Referee Assignments will coincide with experience and ability level.
- 3) Referees who are at the tournament for the sole purpose of officiating will have priority over refs who are coaching, playing, or requesting to watch certain teams play.
- 4) Due to schedule changes and my game matrix having team codes like B14A2, referee who are coaching, playing, or requesting to watch games will not be assigned in the initial schedule. Refs in this category will be used to fill in as needed. This decision is based on 3v3 assigning experiences over the past few years.
- 5) Failure to show up to assigned games will result in not being assigned to future tournaments.
- 6) If any referee has a chance of getting called into work, notify the assignor ASAP. Referees in this position will most likely only be assigned as standby.

Pre Game Procedures

- 1) Check in at the referee area 30 minutes prior to first game time.
- 2) Pick up 3v3 score cards from referee area.
- 3) Fill out as much data on the cards as possible: time, field number, etc.
- 4) Walk out to assigned field and make sure all players have tournament wrist bands on.
- 5) Players should have no jewelry on.
- 6) A normal coin toss is used for teams to determine side and kickoff.

Game Procedures

- 1) Announce the score to the coach's bench after each goal is scored. There has been a lot of controversy over scores. The tournament director would like to eliminate scoring disputes.
- 2) Circle the goal number after each goal.
- 3) Follow overtime procedure printed on the scorecard for playoff games where a winner is needed and the score is tied at the end of the second half.

Post Game Procedures

- 1) Write the final score on the card.
- 2) Hand card to winning coach – remind coach to turn card in at score center.
- 3) In the case of a tie during a pool game, either coach can receive the card.
- 4) For red cards, you need to write up a detailed description and list which send off offense was committed.

Completion of Games

- 1) After your last game of the tournament, go to tournament headquarters and the tournament director will write you a check for all games worked during the weekend.
