

Rules Interpretations

- If any part of the player is touching a line of the goal box, this player is considered “inside the box”.
 - In order for an automatic goal to be awarded, a defending player must make contact with the ball while the ball OR player is “inside the box”.
- All free kicks are indirect.
- The only direct kick is a corner kick.
- A ball must be 100% in the attacking half of the field for a goal to be scored.
 - If the ball is touching the halfway line and the ball goes into the goal, correct restart is goal kick – no goal.
 - If the ball is shot from the defensive half but makes contact with a defender in the attacking half of the field and goes into the goal, the goal is valid.
- All slide tackles are fouls in 3v3.
 - Advantage can be called for tackles as with any other foul.
 - Issues cards for tackles based on severity just like a full sided game.
- A penalty kick may be awarded if a foul is committed to prevent a goal scoring opportunity.
 - Penalty kick are taken from the center of the field on a wide open goal. All players should stand behind the halfway line.
 - The ball is dead after a penalty kick. If a goal is not scored, then the defensive team is awarded a goal kick.
